



Data protection Consent - Customers

The Data Protection Act 1998 & GDPR describe how organisations — including GENERATE THEATRE COMPANY— must collect, handle and store personal information.

These rules apply regardless of whether data is stored electronically, on paper or on other materials.

To comply with the law, personal information must be collected and used fairly, stored safely and not disclosed unlawfully.

Confidentiality
